

The Rev. McHugh Succumbs

Services will be Wednesday for the Rev. Patrick McHugh, who died at his Felton residence Saturday. He was 65.

He was a native of Glenfarne, County Lighrin, Ireland, and had been ordained in 1943. He had been the associate pastor of St. John's Cathedral in Fresno and St. Bridget's in Hanford for five years. He founded Holy Rosary Church of Hilmor in 1948 and became pastor of St. John's of Felton in 1963. He was a member of Knights of Columbus, Council 971 of Santa Cruz.

He is survived by three brothers, Thomas McHugh, Felix McHugh and the Rev. John McHugh of Ireland.

Services will be conducted at St. John's Catholic Church, corner of Russell and Highway 9 in Felton, Wednesday at noon where a Concelebrated Mass of Christian burial will be celebrated with Bishop Harry Clinch officiating. Interment will be at Holy Cross Cemetery Wednesday at 2:30 p.m.

Visitation will be at Norman's Family Chapel, 3620 Soquel Drive, Soquel this evening until 9. Father McHugh will lie in state at St. John's Catholic Church Tuesday at 3 p.m.

Rosary will be recited at St. John's Catholic Church Tuesday evening at 7:30.
