Ordained a Roman Catholic Priest in 1980, Robert Allmen is Pastor of Church of the Good Shepherd in Hampton Bays, New York. He has served at the church since 1987, providing support to a large community of Catholics.

Robert Allmen is a graduate of Georgetown University and Cathedral College of the Immaculate Conception, where he studied psychology, philosophy, and theology. A Fellow of the American Orthopsychiatric Association and a member for more than 25 years, he has earned listing in Who's Who in Human Resources for more than 20 years as well. Allmen is also Executive Director of the Family Counseling Center. He is an outspoken advocate for the protection of children against sex abusers and continues to reach out to the poor, families in crisis, and those who feel alienated from institutional religion.

A member in good standing of the National Association of Wedding Officiants, Robert Allmen also performs wedding ceremonies in Long Island and New York City. The \$500 fee, which includes a \$200 deposit, is tax-deductible and donated to the church. Allmen offers his services for outside weddings and those who are getting remarried, with no annulment necessary.

In addition to traditional Catholic ceremonies, Allmen performs spiritual and more contemporary ceremonies. He also participates in interfaith ceremonies. He usually begins a wedding with a greeting and opening prayer, followed by scripture, poetry, or prose readings. A sermon typically follows, then the exchange of vows. Allmen additionally offers unity candle, sand, and family medallion ceremonies. After a presentation of roses to mothers and fathers, the congregation recites a concluding prayer, a memorial is offered for deceased family members, and the ceremony is concluded with a pronouncement.
