Schedule Mass for Profession by Blume

Brother James Blume, C.S.C., son of Mr. and Mrs. Homer A. Blume, 457 Ridge Rd., will make his final profession of vows in the order of Brothers of Holy Cross next Saturday in Milwaukee.

A native of Mishawaka and a graduate of Mishawaka High School, Brother James received a bachelor of arts degree in theology earlier this month from Marquette University, Milwaukee.

He has been serving for the last two years with the Holy Cross Brothers at the St. Charles Boys Home which they operate in Milwaukee. At present he is in charge of one of the school's dormitories.

Rev. Richard Sanders of Marquette will be the celebrant of the mass at 4 p.m. next Saturday at the home, and hear the vows of both Brother James and Brother Arthur Gohl, C.S.C., also assigned to St. Charles. A dinner for relatives and friends will be served at the school immediately following the profession of vows mass.

Since its founding in 1923, St. Charles has been developed into an effective residential treatment center for emotionally-disturbed boys and has been operated by the Brothers of Holy Cross since 1928 as a part of the Catholic Archdiocese of Milwaukee.
