

Rev. Fiset Arrives in City To Take Over Duties At SS. Peter and Paul Church

Rev. Louis Philippe Fiset, the newly appointed pastor of SS. Peter and Paul Church in Lewiston, has arrived in the city to take over his new assignment. He succeeds Rev. Alexandre Des-Rochers, who returned to Quebec earlier this week after a nine-year stay.

Fr. Fiset was born in Ste-Anne-de-la-Perade, Quebec, on December 5, 1913, and received his primary and secondary education in schools in the Province of Quebec, at Sacred Heart College and at St. Joseph's Seminary.

He entered the Dominican Order on July 26, 1934, and was ordained by Archbishop Joseph William Forbes of Ottawa, Ontario.

From 1941 until 1951, Fr. Fiset served as an assistant at St. Dominic Parish in Quebec City and has been the pastor of the Holy Rosary Church in St. Hyacinth, Quebec, since 1951.

Fr. Fiset has no immediate plans for Maine's largest Roman Catholic Parish, which comprises more than 4,500 families or more than 15,000 persons.
