

**REV. LAWRENCE J. MICHAUD, S.M.**

**VAN BUREN** — Rev. Lawrence J. Michaud, S.M., 80, died unexpectedly Nov. 2, 1990, at his residence in Van Buren. He was born in Van Buren, March 8, 1910, the son of Louis Philippe and Laura (Cormier) Michaud. He attended Sacred Heart School in Van Buren and received his seminary education at St. Mary's College in Van Buren, and Maryvale Seminary in Bedford, Mass. He did his Novitiate training in Statton Island, N.Y., and made his profession to the Society of Mary on Sept. 12, 1930. Fr. Michaud continued his theological studies at Marist College in Washington, D.C., from 1930 to 1936, and was ordained at the Marist College Chapel on June 9, 1936. He served in many parishes in New England: as pastor at Sacred Heart Parish in Lawrence, Mass., St. Joseph Parish in Haverhill, Mass., St. Remi Parish in Keegan, St. Charles Parish in Providence, R.I., and St. Joseph Parish in Hamlin. He served as parochial vicar at Our Lady of Pity in Cambridge, Mass., Sacred Heart Parish in Lawrence, Mass., St. Bruno Parish in Van Buren, St. John the Baptist in Brunswick, St. Joseph Parish in Haverhill, Mass., Our Lady of Victory in Boston and St. Theresa Parish in Methuen, Mass. Fr. Michaud was last assigned to St. Bruno Parish in 1976, where he served as Senior Religious until his retirement. He is survived by a sister, Cecile Violette of St. Leonard, New Brunswick, Canada; and several nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by a brother, Harvey Michaud; and by a sister, Irene Belanger. Relatives and friends may call at the St. Bruno Catholic Church, 336 Main St., Van Buren, 2-4 and 7:30-9 p.m. Monday, and from 1 p.m. until time of services Tuesday. A Mass of Christian Burial will be concelebrated 3 p.m. Tuesday with the Very Rev. Gerard A. Demers, S.M., Provincial Superior of the Marist Fathers of the Northeast Province, as main celebrant.
