

REV. FRANK N. SCHEPERS



Rev. Frank N. Schepers, age 86, passed away October 19, 2002. He was born in Overland Park, KS, on June 6, 1916. He attended Holy Trinity School and graduated from

Rockhurst College with a B.A. Degree. He later worked for the Overland Park post office. Entering the U.S. Army in 1942 during World War II, he served in Okinawa and Omiya, Japan.

After the service, he attended Michigan State University, earning an engineering degree. He was the owner of the Overland Lending Library and Gifts bookstore. In 1950, he entered the seminary at St. Benedict's College and completed his studies at Conception Seminary. He was ordained in 1955 at Queen of the Holy Rosary Catholic Church. A Priest for 48 years, his parishes included Christ the King in Kansas City, KS; Sacred Heart in Mound City; Holy Rosary in Wea; Holy Name in Topeka; and St. John the Baptist in Greeley. He also taught at Ward High School. He was a member of the American Legion for 56 years. He served as State Chaplain and belonged to Post #250 in Louisburg, where he served as Post Chaplain for seven years. He also was a member of the Knights of Columbus.
