

Cardinal Spellman Presiding; Nephew Sings First Mass

WHITMAN, May 6 — Rev. John W. Pegnam, son of Mrs. Marian Pegnam and the late Arthur Pegnam, and nephew of Francis Cardinal Spellman of New York, will sing his first solemn mass at Holy Ghost Church at 10 a.m. tomorrow.

Cardinal Spellman will preside, with Rev. Robert L. Hinchcliffe, P.P., Holy Ghost, Whitman and Rev. Christopher L. Broderick, P.P., St. Patrick, South Yarmouth, as his chaplains. Rt. Rev. Edward B. Broderick, secretary to the cardinal, will be master of ceremonies.

Fr. Pegnam will have as his deacon Rev. James M. Flaherty, assistant, St. Ann, Dorchester; and subdeacon Rev. Frederick W. Savins, assistant at Holy Ghost. Rev. Terence J. Cooke of New York will be assistant priest, and Rev. John E. Boyd, director of charities for Fall River, will be the preacher.

Cardinal Spellman ordained his nephew in ceremonies at St. Patrick's Cathedral on Wednesday. Fr. Pegnam will serve in the Diocese of Fall River.
