

REV. RAYMOND JACQUES

KIMBALL, Minn. — Rev. Raymond Jacques, pastor of St. Ann's parish died here Friday. He was born Nov. 16, 1909, the son of Mr. and Mrs. Charles Jacques, in North Adams, Mass.

He attended Ecole Notre Dame du Sacre-Coeur grade school in North Adams, and completed his preparatory training at St. John's Academy, Rensselaer, N.Y. He took his philosophical and theological training at College de l'Assomption, Worcester, Mass.; St. Bonaventure college and seminary, St. Bonaventure, N.Y.; and St. John's seminary, Collegeville, Minn.

Following his ordination in St. Mary's Cathedral June 6, 1948, he was assigned to the post of assistant pastor at St. Paul's parish, Sauk Centre.

Father Jacques remained there until July of 1950 when he was named assistant pastor of Assumption parish, Morris. In February, 1953, he was appointed pastor of St. Ann's parish here.

Funeral services will be held Wednesday, 10 a.m., from the new St. Ann's church here, with burial in the parish cemetery.
