Father LeBlanc Transfers to St. Jean's in Muskegon

Father David LeBlanc, who has been assistant pastor at St. Mary's Church, has been transferred to St. Jean's Church in Muskegon. He plans to leave August 15 for his new duties. Father LeBlanc has been assistant pastor at St. Mary's since June, 1968. He is the son of Mrs. George LeBlanc of Division street and the late George LeBlanc. He was ordained June 3, 1961 and served at the Blessed Sacrament Church in Grand Rapids until 1964, then to St. Joseph Seminary in Grand Rapids where he served as Rector of High School until 1968. He was Director, Vacation Director from 1968 to 1970 and taught at the St. Charles Grade School in Cheboygan. Last year he helped with the production of "The Ring and the Book" a play which was a great success presented for Cheboygan enjoyment. He is being replaced by Father Francis Partridge from St. James, in Grand Rapids.

Father David E. LeBlanc, age 84, of Caledonia went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, August 20, 2019. Surviving are his sister Dorothy Hanson; sisters-in-law, Leona LeBlanc and Dolores LeBlanc; brother-in-law, Bob Addy; nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, George and Alice LeBlanc; brothers, John and George LeBlanc; sisters Rosalie Lozan, Joan Addy and Mary Alice LeBlanc. For many years Father David served the people of the Diocese of Grand Rapids at the parishes of Blessed Sacrament, Grand Rapids; St. Mary, Cheboygan (part of the Diocese of Grand Rapids at the time); St. Jean Baptiste, Muskegon; St. Francis Xavier, Grand Rapids; St. James, Montague and St. John the Baptist, Claybanks; Holy Spirit, Grand Rapids; and Holy Family, Caledonia. He also served on the faculty of St. Joseph Seminary in Grand Rapids. Since 2007 he has been leading a life of prayer and penance in accordance with the Essential Norms of the Dallas Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People.

The Mass of Christian burial will be celebrated Monday, August 26 at 11 a.m. at SS. Peter and Paul Church in Grand Rapids. Interment will be at Calvary Cemetery, Cheboygan, MI. Visitation will be held Sunday from 4 to 7 p.m. at the Arsulowicz Brothers Remembrance Mortuary and one hour prior to Mass at the church. A Vigil Service will be held Sunday at 6:30 p.m.
