Father David E. LeBlanc, age 84, of Caledonia went to be with the Lord on Tuesday, August 20, 2019. Surviving are his sister Dorothy Hanson; sisters-in-law, Leona LeBlanc and Dolores LeBlanc; brotherin-law, Bob Addy; nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his parents, George and Alice LeBlanc; brothers, John and George LeBlanc; sisters Rosalie Lozan, Joan Addy and Mary Alice LeBlanc. For many years Father David served the people of the Diocese of Grand Rapids at the parishes of Blessed Sacrament, Grand Rapids; St. Mary, Cheboygan (part of the Diocese of Grand Rapids at the time); St. Jean Baptiste, Muskegon; St. Francis Xavier, Grand Rapids; St. James, Montague and St. John the Baptist, Claybanks; Holy Spirit, Grand Rapids; and Holy Family, Caledonia. He also served on the faculty of St. Joseph Seminary in Grand Rapids. Since 2007 he has been leading a life of prayer and penance in accordance with the Essential Norms of the Dallas Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People.

The Mass of Christian burial will be celebrated Monday, August 26 at 11 a.m. at SS. Peter and Paul Church in Grand Rapids. Interment will be at Calvary Cemetery, Cheboygan, MI. Visitation will be held Sunday from 4 to 7 p.m at the Arsulowicz Brothers Remembrance Mortuary and one hour prior to Mass at the church. A Vigil Service will be held Sunday at 6:30 p.m.
