## Assignment Record – Rev. Michael G. Kolar

**Summary of Case**: Kolar was accused of sexually abusing at least three young women while he was director of the St. Paul Youth Center in St. Paul in the 1970s and 1980s. One of his victims was 15 years old when he started grooming her. Kolar admitted to having a problem with vulnerable young women, and that he was a sexual abuser. Kolar was sent to South America to do mission work in 1990. He was removed from ministry in 1991 and laicized in 1993. He went on to marry and died in 2024.

**Priests in a Parish**: We use the following convention to show a priest's place among the clergy of a parish: 1/2 means that he is the first priest listed in the *Official Catholic Directory* (usually the pastor) and that there is a total of two priests at the parish. The shorthand 3/4 means that the priest is listed third on a four-priest roster. See our <u>sample page from the *Directory*</u>.

**Note**: The *Official Catholic Directory* aims to report the whereabouts of Catholic priests in the United States on January 1 of the *Directory*'s publication year. Our working assumption is that a priest listed in the *Directory* for a given year was at the same assignment for part of the previous year as well. However, Kenedy and Sons will sometimes accept updates well into the year of publication. Diocesan clergy records are rarely available to correct this information. The *Directory* is also sometimes misleading or wrong. We have tried to create an accurate assignment record, given the source materials and their limitations. Assignment records are a work in progress and we are always improving the records that we post. Please <u>email us</u> with new information and corrections.

This assignment record collates Kolar's career history as it is represented in the *Official Catholic Directory* with allegations as reported in the media.
