

Rev. John DeAngelis

The Rev. John Bernard DeAngelis, 73, of St. Joseph's Home for the Aged, Jefferson City, died Monday, Feb. 13, 1989.

He was born Sept. 10, 1915, at Trenton, N.J., a son of Peter and Francis Carissimmi DeAngelis.

Rev. DeAngelis attended Immaculate Conception Seminary, Ramsey, N.J., and Conception Seminary, Conception. He was ordained March 18, 1944, in the Cathedral of the Immaculate Conception, Kansas City, for the Diocese of Kansas City. In 1956 he moved to Jefferson City and joined the Diocese of Jefferson City. He held many pastoral assignments under the Diocese of Jefferson City including, administrator of Assumption Parish, Cedron; pastor of St. Anthony Parish, St. Anthony; associate at St. Mary's Parish, Hannibal; pastor of St. Andrew's Catholic Church, Tipton; pastor at Holy Cross Catholic Church, Cuba; pastor at St. Cecilia Church, Meta; as well as many other special assignments in various parishes in the diocese.

Survivors include one brother, Joseph DeAngelis; and one sister, Jean DeAngelis.

Services were at 11 a.m. Thursday at the Chapel at St. Josephs Home for the Aged, with Bishop Michael F. McAuliffe S.T.D. officiating.

Burial was in Our Lady of Lourdes Cemetery, Hamilton Township, N.J.
