

## Rev. Maurer To Go To Louisiana Post

Rev. Arthur R. Maurer, SSJ, pastor of St. Therese Catholic church in Orange, is being transferred to Corpus Christi church, New Orleans, La., it was announced today. He will be assistant pastor of the largest parish for Negro Catholics in the nation, the announcement stated.

His successor here will be the Rev. Edward J. Hennessy, SSJ, former pastor of St. Therese church in Gulfport, Miss.

Rev. Maurer came to Orange in August, 1947, to serve as temporary pastor at St. Therese and has been here ever since.

He completed his theological studies at St. Joseph's seminary, Washington, D. C. and was ordained on June 10, 1947, at the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in the nation's capitol. His first assignment was the Most Pure Heart of Mary church, Mobile, Alabama. From there he came to Orange.

Rev. Maurer is a native of Watertown, Mass. His activities have included duty as assistant chaplain to the local council, Knights of Columbus and Boy Scouts of America.
