St. Vincent Assistant Appointed

The Rev. Paschal A. Morlino, O.S.B., newly appointed assistant pastor of St. Vincent Parish, is a native of Portsmouth, Va.

Entered Monastery

He entered the Benedictine Monastery of Belmont Abbey in North Carolina in 1959 after completing his high school and college work there.

In 1963 he went to Savannah, Ga., to work at Benedictine Military School and when the school and monastery came under the auspices of St. Vincent Archabbey, he transferred to St. Vincent.

Father Paschal's seminary training was conducted at Belmont Abbey, St. Maud's Priory in Kentucky, and at Conception Abbey in Missouri. He has received bachelor degrees in history and theology and holds a masters degree in library science from the University of Pittsburgh.

Belmont Abbey

He taught at Belmont Abbey College, St. Maur's Priory and Savannah Military School. At St. Vincent he was on the faculty of the preparatory school and college, has been circulation librarian and is now a library consultant. He holds membership in The American Library Association, Pennsylvania Library Association, Western Pennsylvania Catholic Library Association and American Benedictine Academy.

Father Paschal is a bi-ritual priest and can celebrate the liturgy both in the Roman and Byzantine rites.
