

CALM ADVOCATED IN AIDING YOUTH

A more rational, calm approach in handling youth was advocated at a meeting of the Canisius High School Fathers Club Monday evening by the Rev. Raymond B. Fullam, S. J., student counselor at the school. He attributed many of youth's problems to the instability among adults. "There is no problem we can't solve if we maintain our proper balance," he said.

Pointing out that youth is not as keyed up about youth problems as adults are, Rev. Fullam observed: "Some of them are laughing up their sleeves at our excitement over delinquency problems." He urged that adults be more sincere in living their religion, suggesting that such action would win back the confidence of youth and be reflected in their actions.
