

# Father Reddy Is Priest 40 Years

Rev. Leo F. Reddy, pastor of St. Patrick's Church, Lockport, was honored on the 40th anniversary of his ordination at a parish reception in the school hall last Sunday.

Born in Geneva, he attended St. Francis de Sales School there and St. Mary's in Dunkirk. He was ordained by Most Rev. William Turner at Niagara University on May 26, 1923.

Father Reddy was an assistant pastor at St. Mary's of the Cataract, Niagara Falls, and St. Mary's, Medina, before he was made a professor at the Diocesan Preparatory Seminary in 1926. In 1932 he served at St. Joseph's, Batavia, and in 1937 went to Our Lady of Perpetual Help.

Father Reddy was there only a few months when he was named pastor of Immaculate Conception, Eden. He remained until 1948 when he assumed the pastorate of St. Joseph's, Fredonia. He was named pastor of St. Patrick's on March 3, 1957.
