

Rev. Vincent Mooney Named Rector of Canisius High

The Rev. Vincent P. Mooney SJ, is the newly-named president and rector of Canisius High School where he has been a student counselor for the past 10 years.

He succeeds the Rev. W. Robert Burns SJ, who will reside at Canisius College. Appointment of Father Mooney was announced by Rev. Joseph T. Browne SJ, provincial of secondary education for the New York Province of the Society of Jesus. Father Burns presently is unassigned.

The new head of the high school was born May 27, 1920 in New York City and is a graduate of Fordham University. He entered the Jesuit order in 1943 and was ordained in St. Mary's Cathedral, San Francisco, June 15, 1956.

He has been moderator of the Western New York Catholic Sodality Union and is a member of the Western New York Guidance Association and the American Personnel & Guidance Association.

Father Burns became president June 16, 1965. He previously had
