Rev. Daniel G. Duggan Dies; Brother of 2 Priests, 2 Nuns

MIDDLEPORT, March 5— The Rev. Daniel G. Duggan, 51, brother of two other Catholic priests and two nuns, died Tuesday after suffering an apparent heart attack in the rectory of St. Stephen's Church on Vernon St. He had been pastor there since 1966.

Father Duggan was a native of North Tonawanda, son of the late John J. and Margaret Fris-

bee Duggan.

He was educated at Ascension Church Parochial School, North Tonawanda; the Diocesan Preparatory Seminary, Buffalo, and was a graduate of Our Lady of the Angels Seminary, Niagara University.

HE EARNED master of arts and master of library science degrees from St. John's University, L. I. Father Duggan was ordained May 22, 1948 at St. Joseph's Cathedral Buffalo, by the late Cardinal John O'Hara.

His diocesan assignments included: 1948-49, Cassadaga Missionary Apostolate; 1942-51, assistant pastor, St. Monica's Church, Buffalo; 1951-52, assistant, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Niagara Falls; 1952-66, teacher at the Diocesan Preparatory Seminary.

He was named pastor of St. Stephen's in 1966.

HE IS survived by three brothers, Msgr. Robert G. Duggan, pastor of St. Margaret's Church, Buffalo; the Rev. John M. Duggan, pastor of St. John the Baptist Church, Lockport, and James E. Duggan of North Tonawanda; three sisters, Sister Mary Kathleen, GNSH, Buffalo; Sister Margaret Mary, SSMN, Kenmore and Mrs. Lucille Breier of North Tonawanda.

The body will lie in state in St. Stephen's rectory today until it is taken to the church tomorrow at 7:30 PM.

Bishop Edward D. Head of the Buffalo Diocese will offer a Concelebrated Mass of Christian Burial at 11 AM Friday in St. Stephen's.
