Rev. Florian A. Jasinski Dies; Pastor of St. Stanislaus Kostka

The Rev. Florian A. Jasinski, 53, pastor of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church in Niagara Falls died Monday (Dec. 19, 1983) in Buffalo General Hospital.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be concelebrated by Bishop Edward D. Head at 10:30 a.m. Thursday at the church, 2437 Niagara St.

A native of Buffalo, Father Jasinski graduated from St. Adalbert's School, St. Joseph's Collegiate Institute and Canisius College.

He attended Our Lady of the Angels Seminary at Niagara University and was ordained March 16, 1957.

His first assignment was at St. Helen's Church in Hinsdale in June 1957. He then served as assistant pastor at St. Patrick's Church in Lockport. He later became associate pastor at St. Josaphat's Church in Cheektowaga and Transfiguration Church in Buffalo before being named pastor in 1974 of St. Stanislaus Kostka in Perry.

In 1982 he was named pastor of St. Stanislaus Kostka in Niagara Falls, a position he held at the time of his death. Father Jasinski was a member of the Knights of Columbus.

He is survived by two brothers, Philip, of Sloan and Edmund and a sister, Arline Dill of Depew.

Prayers will be said at 2 p.m. tomorrow at the Pacer Funeral Home, 2275 George Urban Blvd., Depew. A scripture service will be held at 3 p.m. tomorrow in St. Stanislaus Kostka.
