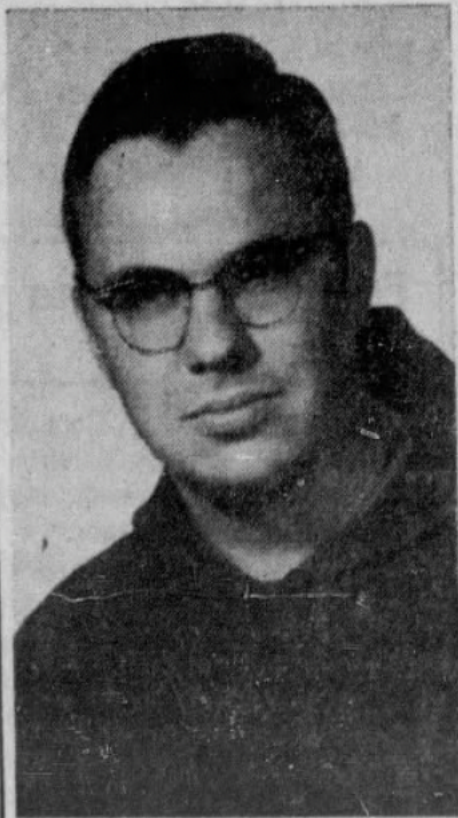


Rev. Armand LaReau To Be Ordained Sept. 1st

Traacy, Bishop of La Crosse, Thursday morning, 8:30 a.m., at St. Mary's Catholic Church, Marathon, Wis. His parents will attend the ordination.

first Solemn Mass at St. Peter's Catholic Church here, Sunday, Sept. 11, 11 a.m. Rev. Raymond Miller, pastor of St. Peter's, will be the assistant priest at the Mass.

The deacon will be Rev. Jude Hahn, O.F.M. Cap., and the subdeacon will be Rev. Ignatius Rue-dinger, O.F.M. Cap. Rev. George Henseler, O.F.M. Cap., will preach the sermon.

A dinner and reception will follow the First Mass. The reception will be from 3:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Benediction will be given at 5:00 p.m.

Rev. Armand, formerly James LaReau, was born in Madison in 1934 and came to Beaver Dam in 1941. He attended St. Peter's School for seven years and received his high school education at St. Lawrence Seminary, Mt. Calvary, Wis. After completing his studies there, he entered the Capuchin Order and spent his first year of training at Detroit, Mich. Rev. Armand took his college studies at Huntington, Ind., where he received a B.A. degree with a major in philosophy. He is now completing his theological studies at the Capuchin Seminary of St. Anthony, Marathon, Wis.
