Capuchin to profess final vows

Capuchin Brother Leonard Gibeault, son of Mr. and Mrs. Leonard Gibeault, 2011 12th St., Two Rivers, will profess solemn religious vows Saturday in the chapel of St. Lawrence Seminary, Mt. Calvary, Wis. A reception and dinner will follow the ceremonies.

Brother Gibeault will profess vows of poverty, chastity and obedience for life as a member of the Midwest Capuchin Province of St. Joseph.

The oldest of 10 children, Brother Gibeault was a 1965 graduate of Washington High School, Two Rivers. He attended the University of Wisconsin and Lakeshore Technical Institute before entering the armed forces in 1967. Following a tour of duty in Vietnam he was discharged in 1970. He attended Silver Lake College from 1970-74, majoring in education and social sciences.

Following his graduation from Silver Lake, he taught at Two Rivers Catholic Central. He spent a year in the Capuchin pre-novitiate at Milwaukee and was then invested as a Capuchin novice on Aug. 11, 1978.

Brother Gibeault is stationed at St. Bonaventure Friary, Detroit, Mich., where he is serving as vocational counselor for St. Lawrence Seminary for the State of Michigan.
