Priest Bound While Two Loot Youth Center

ST. LOUIS (UPI)—Two armed men tied up a Catholic seminarian and threatened him with death Saturday, at a St. Louis youth center.

Police said the seminarian, Rev. James Beine, 25, was bound with an electric cord and rolled up in a blanket, while the two men ransacked the youth center and a basement bowling alley.

Father Beine said one of the men threatened "to shoot me if I made a sound, and after about an hour of being tied up, I hobbled to a telephone to summon police."

The two men fled with \$11 in coins and a typewriter and a radio. Father Beine, a Catholic deacon, said he expects to be ordained a priest next spring, and that he was assigned to the youth center for the summer.
