Brother Louis Meinhardt

Brother Louis Meinhardt, S.M., 88, died in San Antonio, Texas, on December 18, 1990, of the infirmities of age. Brother Meinhardt, son of the late William and Louise Meinhardt, was born in St. Louis. He attended Kenrick, McKinley, and Cleveland High Schools and Missouri Business School before entering the Society of

Mary in 1922.

He received his Master's degree in Education from St. Louis University and taught English, language, math, and business courses in several elementary and high schools in Iowa, Illinois, Michigan, Texas and Missouri. He was principal twice at the old Central Catholic in East St. Louis (he was on the pioneer faculty roster in 1929) and in Detroit, and directed the Maryhurst Normal School in Kirkwood in the 50's. Prior to his retirement in San Antonio in 1989, he was at Chaminade College Prep for over 30 years, where he had also been stationed on three previous occasions.

Brother Meinhardt was coach, athletic director, and moderator of school papers and yearbooks. In his latter years at Chaminade he served as a volunteer at St. John's Mercy Medical Center.

Funeral services and interment were at St. Mary's University in San Antonio. He is survived by several nieces and nephews, mostly all of the St. Louis area.
