## One-Day Retreat Planned Sunday For Biloxi Women

The Rev. Francis Reid of Jackson will conduct a day of recollection for the women of Biloxi Sunday at Sacred Heart Academy on Fayard St.

Father Reid studied at Carlow College, Carlow, Ireland, and after coming to this country was assigned as assistant pastor of St. Joseph's Church, Greenville, Miss. From there he went to Jackson as secretary to Bishop Gerow.

Later he was sent to the Catholic University of America to take a graduate studies in Canon Law. He received a Doctorate in Canon Law from the university and is now officialis for the marriage court of the diocese. Father Reid also helped establish the Mississippi Register and was its first editor.

The one-day retreat for women, is sponsored by the Nativity Parish Sodality and will begin with the 8:30 a.m. Mass Sunday and end with a Holy Hour at 4 p.m.
