Rev. Anthony Brown of Carroll First to Be Granted Doctor's Degree at Montana

The first earned doctor's degree to be granted by Montana State university, Missoula, will be conferred in March upon the Rev. Anthony Brown, according to Dr. Ellis Waldron, dean of the Graduate School.

Father Brown will receive the degree of doctor of education, which is conferred "in recognition of breadth of scholarly attainment and demonstrated ability to investigate problems independently and effectively rather than the completion of a set curriculum in a certain period of residence."

The program leading to the doctor of education degree was instituted at the university in 1955, and Father Brown is the first candidate to complete the degree. Dean Waldron said that several other candidates are currently in residence and completing requirements for the doctorate in education.
