

Appointment changes made for area diocese

Bishop Thomas J. Murphy of the Diocese of Great Falls-Billings has announced the following clergy appointments, to take place July 1.

Retiring priests will be the Rev. Msgr. Joseph Gluszek, currently pastor of St. Joseph's parish in Big Timber; the Rev. Michael Kelly, currently pastor of St. Peter's parish in Wibaux; and the Rev. Patrick Moran, presently serving at Sacred Heart Seminary in Hales Corners, Wis.

The Rev. John Dimke will go from St. Luke's parish in Great Falls to St. Mathias parish in Moore with responsibility for the communities of Danvers and Hobson. He has been named for a second term as head of the Diocesan Liturgical Commission and to the summer graduate program in liturgy at the University of Notre Dame.

The Rev. Izidorius Gedvila, pastor of St. Mathias parish in Moore, will move to St. Joseph's parish in Big Timber with responsibility for the community of Reed Point.

The Rev. Richard Hopkins, associate pastor of St. Patrick's co-cathedral parish in Billings will be pastor of St. Peter's parish in Wibaux with responsibility for the community of St. Philip's.

The Rev. John Houlihan will return from sabbatical leave at the University of Notre Dame to the position of pastor at St. Luke's parish in Great Falls.

The Rev. Kirk Morgan, associate pastor of Sacred Heart parish in Miles City will be pastor of St. Raphael's parish in Glasgow with responsibility for the communities of Nashua and Fort Peck.

The Rev. Richard Munsell, associate pastor of St. Raphael's parish in Glasgow, will be associate pastor of St. Matthew's parish in Sidney and will also serve the communities of Fairview, Lambert, Richey and Savage.

The Rev. Anthony Schuster will leave St. Matthew's parish in Sidney to co-pastor St. Pius X parish in Billings.

The Rev. Anthony Slane, now at St. Gerard's parish in Great Falls and providing a special ministry to the deaf community, will move to Our Lady of Good Help parish in Ho-

quiam, Wash.

The Rev. Gregory Staudinger, newly ordained, will be associate pastor of St. Raphael's parish in Glasgow and assist with the communities of Nashua and Fort Peck.

The Rev. Edward Zabrocki will change from teaching full time at Billings Central High School to become associate pastor of St. Patrick's co-cathedral in Billings and continue teaching part time.

The Rev. William Cawley will be doing graduate work in education and teaching part time at Billings Central.

The Rev. Jerry Connolly, currently chaplain at Billings Newman Club, will take a year's sabbatical leave.

The Rev. Robert Grosch, associate pastor of Holy Family Parish in Great Falls, will become editorial advisor to the "Montana Catholic Register."

The Rev. Michael Kirkness will change from being associate pastor of St. Bernard's parish in Billings to becoming chaplain of the Newman Club serving the college communities of Eastern Montana College and Rocky Mountain College.

The Rev. Kevin Malce is taking a leave of absence from his post as associate pastor of St. Pius X parish in Billings to serve the Diocese of Phoenix, Ariz.
