


WILL BE ORDAINED ON THURSDAY

DE PERE—The Rt. Rev. Paul P. Rhode, Bishop of Green Bay, will confer holy orders at 8 o'clock tomorrow morning at St. Joseph's shrine, in St. Joseph's church. The Rev. David Edwin Rondou, Green Bay, and the Rev. Peter P. Pritzl, Hollandtown, members of the Praemonstratensian order, will be ordained to the holy priesthood. John Murphy, a student of St. Francis' seminary, Milwaukee, will receive the deaconship, and three or four Franciscans will receive minor orders during the solemn ceremonies over which the bishop will preside.

The Rev. Pritzl and the Rev. Rondou received their elementary schooling at Holland and Green Bay, re-

spectively. In September 1918 both enrolled at St. Norbert's college for their secondary education, and on Aug. 28, 1923 they were received into the Norbertine order, and they continued studies at the abbey here.

The Rev. Pritzl is the son of Wolfgang Pritzl, and he will celebrate his first holy mass in St. Francis' church, Hollandtown, his home parish, on Sunday, April 28.

The Rev. Rondou is a son of Mr. and Mrs. Louis Rondou, 624 Doty-st., Green Bay, and he will offer up the Holy Sacrifice for the first time Sunday, April 28, in St. Willebrord's church, where he was an altar boy and attended the school until he entered the college here.
