

Mother Marianne Rites Friday at St. Ignatius

Mother Marianne Adams, 80, veteran of mission work in Montana when she went from one point to another to teach Indians, died Wednesday at St. Ignatius.

Last rites for the aged Sister were held Friday morning at the St. Ignatius Catholic church and burial was made in the Catholic cemetery there.

Mother Marianne was born March 26, 1876, and entered the Ursuline order November 13, 1894. She was one of a family of 12, of whom two became Jesuit Fathers, four entered the Ursuline order and one entered the Franciscan order.

Three survivors are her youngest sister, Mother Emmanuel, who is supervisor of the Ursuline academy in Great Falls, and a brother and sister in Lancaster, Wisconsin.

The Sullivan mortuary at St. Ignatius had charge of arrangements.
