


TO BE ORDAINED



REV. JOHN J. BERUBE

Rev. John J. Berube, MS, of 17 Eagle St., will be ordained to the priesthood on the 30th by Most Rev. Russell J. McVinney, bishop of Providence, in the Cathedral of Sts. Peter and Paul at Providence, R. I.

A native of Hartford, Conn., Fr. Berube was graduated from St. Thomas Aquinas School in Brightwood and attended Cathedral High School. In 1943, he entered LaSalette Preparatory Seminary in Enfield, N. H., later studying at the Novitiate of the Franco-American Province in East Brewster and at LaSalette Major Seminary in Attleboro.

On the 31st, Fr. Berube will celebrate his first solemn high mass in St. Thomas Aquinas Church at 11 a. m. Rt. Rev. Msgr. William Leclaire will be assistant priest; Rev. Louis Lafontaine, cousin of Fr. Berube, will be deacon and Rev. Raymond Potvin, subdeacon.

Rev. Roland Bedard, provincial councilor of the LaSalette Congregation, will preach. A reception for relatives and friends will be held in St. Thomas Aquinas Hall from 3 to 6.
