

Rev. Hartman Will Greet All Visitors

The Rev. Robert Hartman, resident chaplain at the Home of the Good Shepherd, will be present to welcome guests and answer questions concerning the home, during its open house and coffee hour, between 2 and 6 p.m.

Fr. Hartman, who teaches religion at Cathedral High School, directs the Cathedral choiristers, comprised of boys and men of Cathedral parish. He is known throughout Helena for his participation in civic activities, especially those for young people.

A native of Helena, he moved to Bozeman with his family when he was three years of age. He attended Carroll College and St. Edwards Seminary in Kenmore, Wash.

He was assigned to St. Patrick's parish in Butte after being ordained a priest in 1947 at St. Helena Cathedral. In September, 1949, he was assigned to the Cathedral parish where he remained until he became resident chaplain at the home in August, 1956.
