

## Sister Clement M. Schmieder

Sister Clement Marie Schmieder, 88, of 2300 Central Ave., died of natural causes Monday at a local nursing home.

A vigil service will be 7:30 p.m. Wednesday at the Ursuline Centre Chapel. Funeral services will be 10 a.m. Thursday at the Ursuline Centre Chapel. Burial will be at Mount Olivet Cemetery. Memorials are suggested to the Ursuline Centre.

She was born June 17, 1903, in Frankfurt, Germany. She graduated from the University of Frankfurt, earning her degree in music with emphasis on piano, flute and clarinet.

She came to the United States to enter the Ursuline Order as a missionary sister. After completing her novitiate in Mukilteo, Wash., she made her religious vows in the Ursuline Order on June 1, 1929.

Her teacher career spanned 50 years, taking her to Everett, Wash., and Pilgrim Springs, Alaska. In Montana she served in St. Ignatius, Anaconda and at Our Lady of Lourdes in Great Falls. After retirement she did remedial work with students of the then-Holy Family School. She also taught private music lessons and did extensive home visiting in Holy Family Parish.

She withdrew from active ministry in 1985 due to ill health.

She is survived by a nephew, Bernhard Schmieder of Frankfurt, Germany.
