Summary:

- Father Albert J. Powers was accused of sexually abusing a male minor child on at least 3 occasions from approximately 1964 when the boy was approximately 9 years old until approximately 1965 when the boy was approximately 10 years old. The sexual abuse occurred in St. Mary's Church in Charlestown, MA. During the time of the sexual abuse, Father Powers was assigned to St. Mary's Church, and the boy was a parishioner at the church.
- The sexual abuse by Father Powers consisted of Father Powers fondling the boy's penis and testicles skin on skin.
- The claim settled in 2025 in the five figures.
