



REV. JOHN WANZEK ORDAINED MAY 30

**New Priest Will Celebrate High Mass
in Wells Sunday, June 4— Dinner
in His Honor**

A dinner will be served in St. Casimir School Auditorium at noon Sunday, June 4, honoring the Rev. John Wanzek, who was ordained at Jamestown, N. D., Tuesday, May 30, and who celebrated his first Solemn Mass at St. Mathias Church in Windsor, N. D., at 9 o'clock on the morning of June 1. Father Wanzek will come to Wells and will celebrate High Mass in St. Casimir Church at 9:30 o'clock for the benefit of those relatives who were unable to attend the Solemn Mass in Windsor. The public is invited, both to the church and to the dinner.

The sixth of eleven children, Father Wanzek was born at Windsor, N. D., on June 5, 1918, the son of August Wanzek and Anna Schultz.

After grade school work in rural Windsor, he took his high school course at Assumption Abbey, Richardton, and St. John Academy, Jamestown. He took his college work at Holy Cross Seminary, Notre Dame and St. John's, Collegeville, and finished Theology at St. John's, Collegeville.

He has one sister in the convent, Sister Rosanne, C. S. J., St. Agnes Convent, Ghent, Minn.

Father Wanzek's mother was a daughter of the late Felix Schultz of this community. His father is a brother of Frank Wanzek, Sr., and Mrs. John A. Staloch.
