

St. Ignatius Indian School Children Need Band Instruments

ANACONDA — Indian children at the Villa Ursula school at St. Ignatius are musically inclined and have hopes of organizing a band if they can obtain the band instruments, Mother Finbarr, a former member of the faculty at St. Paul school here, announced.

The venerable Ursuline sister expressed hope that the residents of Anaconda and Butte who have band instruments not in use might donate them to the school and the needy Indian children may get a start on a musical organization. An Indian employe at the school formerly directed bands in Oregon and has volunteered his services in teaching the children.

The band instruments may be forwarded to Sister Finbarr at the Ursuline Convent at St. Ignatius, Mont.
