

### Rev. Victor Heinen, 44, Conception Abbey Monk, Dies in St. Francis

The Reverend Victor Heinen, O. S. B., 44, monk of Conception Abbey, Conception, died Wednesday morning at St. Francis hospital. Father Victor, born at Mio, Ia., made his religious profession as a member of Conception Abbey in 1931.

He was ordained a priest in 1934. His first assignment was that of assistant professor of biology at Conception Seminary. From 1937 to 1940 Father Victor held the position of business manager of Conception Abbey.

From 1940 to 1951 he was active in parochial work in the Dakota missions. In 1951 Father Victor returned to Conception Abbey and since that time had been professor of biological and zoological science in the seminary. During the year 1951 to 1952 he also acted as chaplain of St. Francis hospital in Maryville.

A pontifical Requiem Mass and burial will be at 9 o'clock Friday morning at Conception Abbey.

Father Victor is survived by his father, Andrew J. Heinen of Moberly; four sisters and four brothers.
