

Father Joseph La Manna Moved To Noonan As St. Luke's Pastor

Among new assignments for Catholic priests in the diocese of Bismarck announced Saturday by the Most Rev. Hilary Hacker, D.D., bishop of Bismarck, is the re-assignment of the Rev. Joseph LaManna from Mandan to Noonan, and the assignment of Rev. Theodore Gustin and Rev. Eugene Frank to St. Joseph parish as assistant pastors.

Father La Manna will be pastor of St. Luke's Church at Noonan and the missions of Columbus

and Lignite. He was ordained in the Cathedral of the Holy Spirit at Bismarck May 30, 1951, and served as assistant pastor at St. Mary's Church in New England for two years before being transferred in the same capacity to St. Joseph's Church.
