

## S. J. de-Burgo, Cook, 89, Dies

Serafim J. deBurgo, 89, of 6 Stewart St., formerly a cook in restaurants here, died last night in Newport Hospital.

He was born in Brava, the Cape Verde Islands, on Sept. 25, 1881, and resided in Newport for 57 years. He was a member of the Cape Verde Club of Newport.
