Brother Cletus Rausch, 49, a member of the Christian Brothers of Winona Province, will be vice principal at Columbus High School for the 1983-84 academic year.

He also holds a B.A. degree from St. John's University, Collegeville, Minn.; a master's degree in education from St. Mary's College, Winona, Minn.; and an education specialist degree in secondary administration from St. Thomas College, St. Paul, Minn.

His teaching experiences include high school English, religion and music.

Rausch, who enjoys swimming, racquetball, skiing and travel, is temporarily residing at St. John's Parish rectory.
