

Rev. L. Talty

The Rev. Laurence R. Talty, 70, St. Vincent's Nursing Home, Bismarck, died Aug. 22, 1989, in a Bismarck nursing home. Services will be held at 11 a.m. Friday at Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, Bismarck, with Bishop John F. Kinney officiating. Burial will be in St. Mary's Cemetery, Bismarck.

Rev. Talty was born March 31, 1919, at St. Paul, Minn. He was ordained Nov. 30, 1945, at Cathedral of the Holy Spirit, where he served as assistant pastor. He served as assistant pastor at Church of St. Joseph, Williston, from 1947-1948 and then was pastor at Church of St. Michael, Sentinel Butte, until 1953. He served as pastor at Church of St. Anthony, Donnybrook, until he was named administrator of St. John's Chapel, Riverdale, in 1959. He served as pastor at Church of St. Edwin, Washburn from 1967-1974, when he became pastor at Church of St. Martin at Center. He served as pastor at Church of St. Mary in Hague until 1985, when he moved to Bismarck to become director of Emmaus Place. He also served as director of the Catholic Boys Camp at Lake Metigoshe from 1949-1959 and as director of Camp Dominic Savio at Riverdale from 1960-1983.

He is survived by one sister, Marjorie Joyce, North St. Paul, Minn.; and one brother, James, Fargo. (Buehler Funeral Home, Mandan)
