

Catholic Mission To Be Conducted At F. B. Next Week

Rev. Mario Bordignon, P.S. S.C., will conduct a Mission in English at Our Lady of Good Counsel Catholic Church, from Monday, March 22, through March 28th at 7:30 p.m.

It has been some time since a mission has been preached in English here as previous missions have been in the Italian language. It is hoped that many will attend.

Father Bardignon is a native of Cassola, Italy, a town near Venice.

He was made a priest in 1950 and was first assigned to the Church of Santissimo Redentore in Rome. On coming to America in May 1951, Fr. Bordignon was stationed at St. Anthonys, New Haven. He became a U.S. Citizen in 1957.

He was appointed pastor of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Church, Bristol, Rhode Island, on Sept. 12, 1959. In July, 1964, he was sent by his superiors to work as a missionary for the Italian Catholic Federation.

The local branch 182, of the Italian Catholic Federation has been instrumental in bringing Fr. Bordignon to Fort Bragg at this time, and at the close of the mission will honor him with a social gathering in the parish hall.
