

Rev. Leo A. Allyson

MANCHESTER – The Rev. Leo A. Allyson, 81, of 235 Myrtle St., brother of a Suncook resident, died yesterday at a local hospital after a long illness.

He was a native of Manchester and was ordained to the priesthood in Manchester on May 24, 1934, after graduating from the Grand Seminary in Montreal, Quebec. He served as associate pastor of Guardian Angel Church in Berlin from 1934 to 1943, at St. Aloysius Church in Nashua from 1943 to 1945 and at Sacred Heart Church in Lebanon from 1945 to 1950.

He was named pastor of Sacred Heart Church in Marlborough in 1950 and remained there until his retirement in 1976. He has lived at Mt. Carmel Nursing Home since his retirement.

He leaves a brother; a sister, Henriette Rainville of Suncook; and nieces and nephews.

A Mass of Christian burial will be celebrated tomorrow at 10:30 a.m. at the chapel of Mt. Carmel Nursing Home, 235 Myrtle St., Manchester.

Bishop Odore J. Gendron will be celebrant.

Burial will be at Mount Calvary Cemetery.
