

## St. Gregory's Academy Gets First Rector

The Rev. Arnaud Devillers, F.S.S.P., regional superior of the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter, has announced the appointment of the Rev. James W. Jackson, Wichita, Kan., as rector of St. Gregory's Academy, Elmhurst.

Father Jackson, a priest of the Diocese of Wichita, completed his theological studies at Mount St. Mary's Seminary in Emmitsburg, Md. He was ordained in 1985 and has served the Diocese of Wichita in parish and education ministry. During the Gulf War he served as a Navy chaplain and is currently a chaplain in the Navy Reserve.

St. Gregory's Academy, which will open in September, is a boarding and day school for boys. It is under the direction of the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter and will offer a classical liberal arts education within the Catholic intellectual and spiritual tradition.

In addition to Father Devillers, the Rev. Daniel W. Oppenheimer, FSSP, and the Rev. Karl A. Pikus, FSSP, serve in the Tridentine Latin Mass and Sacraments Ministry of the Diocese of Scranton.
