

## **Latin Mass to Be Said at St. Augustine's**

A traditional Latin Mass will be celebrated by the Rev. James W. Jackson at 9 a.m. each Sunday at St. Augustine's Church, 1728 E. Apache St.

Jackson, of the Priestly Fraternity of St. Peter, was sent to Tulsa by the fraternity at the request of Bishop Edward J. Slattery to provide the traditional Mass and sacraments. Daily Mass will also be celebrated at 7 a.m. Monday through Friday.

The traditional Latin Masses celebrated in union with the local bishop and the Holy See are generally called "Indult Masses," referring to permission granted by the Holy See to celebrate them.

The Fraternity of St. Peter was authorized in 1988 by Pope John Paul II. The fraternity is dedicated to the celebration of what is commonly known as the Tridentine Mass in Latin, and other sacraments, according to the liturgical norms in use as established by Pope John XXIII in 1962.
