

Priest at St. Michael's Shifted to Elizabeth

The Rev. Peter F. Zemeikis, assistant at St. Michael's Church, has been named administrator of Ss. Peter and Paul Church, Elizabeth. The announcement was made by Archbishop Thomas Boland and is effective Saturday.

Father Zemeikis has been assigned to the Bayonne church since his ordination in 1957.

A native of Elizabeth, he attended the parochial school of Ss. Peter and Paul Church, Elizabeth, and continued his studies at Seton Hall Prep and Seton Hall University. He received his bachelor of arts degree from Seton Hall in 1953. He then entered Immaculate Conception Seminary, Darlington, and was ordained to the priesthood on May 25, 1957.

Active in Lithuanian affairs, Father Zemeikis was appointed in 1961 as spiritual moderator of the New York-New Jersey District of the Knights of Lithuania. An honorary member of the local American-Lithuanian Citizens Club, he has served as moderator of almost all of the various parish societies and organizations.
