

Rev. Manus Denis Duffy Ordained on Saturday

The Reverend Manus Denis Duffy, son of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph D. Duffy of Exeter Road, was ordained to the priesthood at services held on Saturday in St. Mary's Abbey

Church Morristown. Bishop Lawrence B. Casey of the Paterson Diocese officiated.

A Benedictine monk from St. Mary's Abbey, Father Manus will concelebrate his initial Mass on Sunday at the Morristown Church. The Reverend Slade Crawford of Birmingham, Ala., will be homilist at Father Manus' first mass. The deacon will be the Reverend Bucky Jackson of Tullahoma, Tenn., and the master of ceremonies, Brother Jeremias Donovan, O.S.B. of St. Mary's Abbey. Rt. Rev. Martin Burne, O.S.B., Abbot of St. Mary's Abbey, will speak at a dinner at the Hotel Winfield Scott, Elizabeth, following the ceremony.

Father Manus graduated from Delbarton School in 1960, attended St. John's University, Collegeville, Minn., and St. Bernard College, Cullman, Ala., graduating from St. Benedict's College, Atchison, Kans., in 1965. He pursued theological studies at St. Mary's Abbey School of Theology for four years and at Drew University Theological School, Madison. He is currently teaching Spanish at Delbarton.
