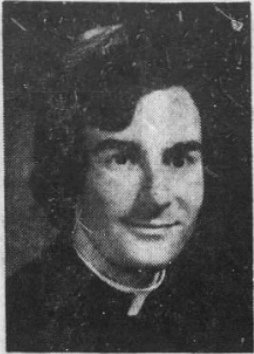


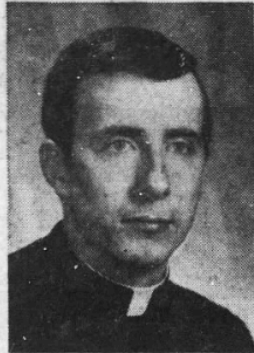
New priests will offer masses in Bergen



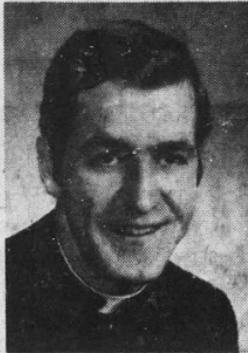

On May 27 at 1:30 p.m. he will celebrate his first mass at St. Mary's Church, Rutherford.

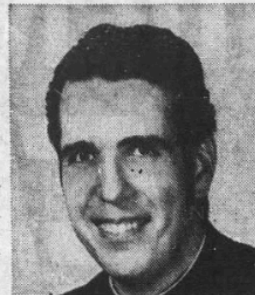
The homilist will be Rev. Salvatore A. Busichio of Our Lady of Peace, New Providence.

Father Burke marking 40 years as a priest

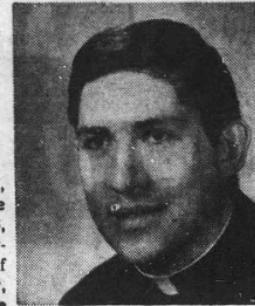
