Father Donohue, first Mass

Rev. John J. Donohue, of Wallkill, N.Y., a native of Jersey City, will concelebrate his first Mass tomorrow at 3 p.m. in St. Aloysius Church, Jersey City, his home parish. Son of John Donohue and the late Ann S. Donohue, he was ordained in Sacred Heart Cathedral, Newark, today, by Archbishop Thomas A. Boland. He is the only diocesan priest ordained today who was born in Jersey City. Father Donohue is presently deacon at St. Mary's Church, Jersey City, and volunteer chaplain of the Hudson-Hamilton Council, Boy Scouts of America. The Mass will be concelebrated with Msgr. John J. Cassels, pastor of St. Aloysius; Rev. William P. Devine, pastor of St. Mary's; Rev. Thomas F. Olsen, Hudson County CYO Director; Rev. Michael Pascual, C.R.; Rev. Hugh V. Fitzgerald, who will preach the sermon; Rev. Victor Sison, Rev. Timothy F. Hourihan, Rev. William J. Reilly, Rev. Robert T. Svec; and Rev. Sergio Reyes. Minor ministers will be Dennis Kaelin, members of the Boy Scouts and St. Mary's altar boys.
