

Three Join Staff Of Catholic Group

The Catholic Youth Department for the Diocese of El Paso has announced the addition of three new members to its staff. Sister Yolanda Tarango, Sister Leola Ann Doerfler and Brother Kerry Guillory joined the youth office this fall.

Sister Yolanda Tarango is a member of the Sisters of Charity of the Incarnate Word, and is originally from El Paso. The daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Daniel Tarango, Sister Yolanda is a graduate of Father Yermo High School. She joined the Incarnate Word Sisters upon graduating from high school and received her B.A. degree from Incarnate Word College in San Antonio. Her work has been primarily with youth. She spent three years working as a social worker at the St. Joseph's Residential Treatment Center in Dallas and has taught at St. Mary's Elementary School. In addition to her youth work, Sister Yolanda served as secretary for the Texas Catholic Conference General Assembly from 1972-74, and is presently secretary for the El Paso Sister's Diocesan Council.

lic Youth Department, she has been appointed diocesan coordinator of Parish Youth Groups. She will be working directly with youth clubs, participating in the development and implementation of training and leadership programs for both youth and adults involved in youth club programs.

Sister Leola Ann Doerfler is a member of the Congregation of Divine Providence. Born in Chicasha, Okla., she comes from a family of 10 children. Upon graduating from high school, Sister Leola entered the religious life, receiving a B.A. degree from Our Lady of the Lake College in San Antonio, and her Master's Degree from Texas Women's University in Denton. Her work prior to coming to the El Paso Diocese has also been primarily with youth. Sister Leola has taught high school in a number of schools in both Texas and Oklahoma. In addition, she has been active in parish ministry, elementary religious education and with the Catholic Youth Organization.

As a member of the Catholic Youth Department, Sister Leola has been appointed Deanery Youth Coordinator for the Las Cruces Deanery of the El Paso Diocese. She will be involved with the coordination of youth activities for the deanery, which includes Las Cruces, Alamogordo, Tularosa, Anthony, and towns inbetween.

Also appointed a Deanery Youth Coordinator is Brother Kerry Guillory, who is a member of the Franciscan Order. Brother Kerry was born in Lawtell, La. leaving in 1966 to join the Franciscan community.

After three years in the novitiate and formation program at St. Peter's in Louisville, Kentucky, he went to Washington, D.C. where he attended college.

There he assumed responsibility for the parish youth program, directing the CYO club. In the fall of 1974, already familiar with the El Paso Diocese, he was made a full time employe of the Catholic Youth Department, and appointed Youth Coordinator for the Carlsbad Deanery, which included Carlsbad, Artesia, Hobbs and towns inbetween.
