Greenfield man professes vows

Brother Malachy Robert Flavin, OSB, son of Mrs. Edward Flavin, of Greenfield, and the late Edward Flavin, made solemn profession of vows a week ago as a monk of the Order of St. Benedict at St. Mary's Abbey, Morristown, N.J.

The profession of vows took place in the Abbey Church with Abbot Brian H. Clarke, OSB, presiding.

Brother Malachy is a Greenfield native and a parishioner of Holy Trinity Parish. He is a graduate of Holy Cross Seminary, Dunkirk, N.Y., and St. Anselm's College, Manchester, N.H., where he was active in the Anselmian Abbey Players and summer theater.

He received his BA degree from St. Anselm's in 1972. He entered St. Mary's Abbey in 1974 and professed Simple Vows in 1975.

Brother Malachy is a member of the History Department at Delbarton School as well as bookstore manager and sacristan of the Abbey Church.
