

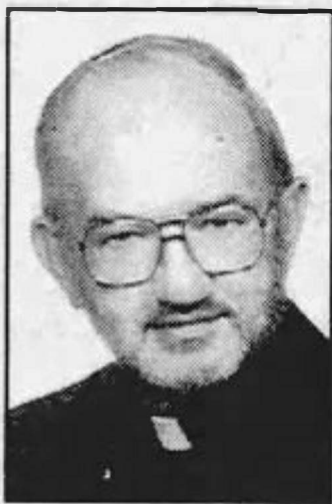
Rev. Anthony M. Kramarz, Catholic priest for 42 years

SAYREVILLE — The Rev. Anthony M. Kramarz, a retired priest of the Metuchan Diocese, died Thursday at St. Michael Hospital, Newark.

Born in Trenton, he graduated from St. Hedwig's Elementary School. He graduated from Trenton Catholic Boys High School.

He attended St. Mary College and SS. Cyril and Methodius Seminary in Orchard Lake, Mich. He was ordained a priest in 1950 at St. Mary Cathedral, Trenton, by Bishop George Ahr. He celebrated his first Mass at his home parish of St. Hedwig's.

He was assigned as associate pastor to St. Stephen Church, Perth Amboy, and later served at St. Stanislaus Church, Sayreville, Holy Cross Church, Trenton, and St. Mary Church, Bound Brook.

He was named administrator of Holy Family Church in Carteret. He was appointed pastor of Mary, Mother of God Church in Flagtown. He served as chaplain to the Carrier Clinic of Belle Mead. He was named pastor of St. Stanislaus Kostka Church in Sayreville. During this pastorate, he accepted the Sisters Minor of Mary Immaculate who follow the spirituality of Fr. Maximilian Kolbe, Saint. He was the spiritual adviser for the Sodality, Rosary-Altar Society, St. Joseph's Society and Holy Trinity Society. He was chaplain of the Boy Scouts Athletic Association. He retired from active ministry in the Diocese of Metuchen in 1992.

He was chaplain of the New Jersey State PBA Local 98 of Sayreville and Hillsborough Township Volunteer Fire Co. 2. He was police chaplain with the Middlesex County Police and with the County of Middlesex Sheriff's Office.

Son of the late Peter and Caroline Oleksiak Kramarz, and brother of the late Frances Gorka, he is sur-

vived by a sister and brother-in-law, Mary P. and Frank Czaplicki of Trenton; a brother and sister-in-law, Walter P. and Anna Kramarz of Trenton; and several nieces and nephews.

A Mass of Jesus Christ the High Priest will be celebrated 7 p.m. Sunday at St. Hedwig's Church, Trenton. The Rev. Stanley Jarosz, pastor of Holy Trinity Church, Helmetta, will officiate.

A Funeral Liturgy will be celebrated noon Monday at St. Hedwig's Church with Bishop Vincent D. Breen, Bishop of Metuchen Diocese, officiating.

Interment will be in the family plot in St. Hedwig's Cemetery, Ewing.

Calling hours will be 4:30 to 7 p.m. Sunday and 10 a.m. to noon Monday at the church.
